Where to draw the line

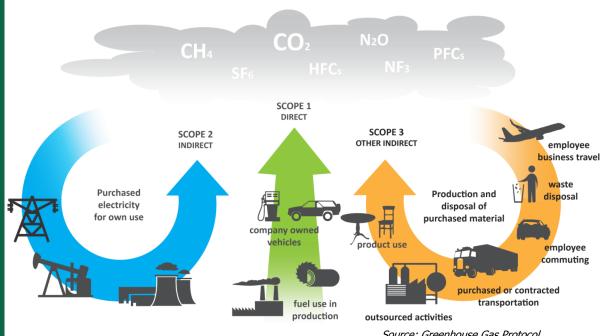
GHG emissions have been categorised into three broad scopes:

Scope 1 accounts for direct emissions from own fuel use.

Scopes 2 and 3 come from indirect sources, and while your company may not have direct control, it remains equally important.

A carbon footprint...

is comprised of the total set of emissions from carbon dioxide (CO₂) as well as five other greenhouse gases.



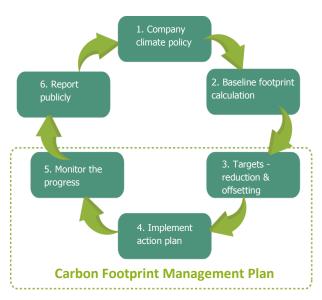
